2.0 Clerk Updates

Item 152 – The Section 6 Biodiversity and Resilience of Ecosystems Duty Report 2025 has been published on our website and shared with One Voice Wales.

The Community Hub will launch as a trial on Tuesday's 1pm-3pm at Trelewis Community Centre on Tuesday 13th January.

The Clerk is in discussions with another Clerk introduced via One Voice Wales to establish the most appropriate way to setup the food pantry. Proposals will then be shared with a view to opening asap.

The complaint received from a resident in Stormtown regarding the position of the Christmas lights in 2025 has been responded to and the resident has confirmed the matter is closed. The lighting company had to move the lights to two different posts due to power outlet issues on the posts at the entrance to Stormtown.

The second phase of the Community Review has closed and there was a face-to-face consultation held by Democratic Services at the Community Hub in December. A further report will now be presented to MTCBC Full Council.

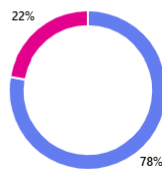

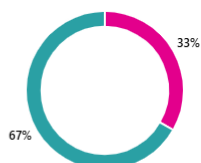
