- Positive action was taken by SWP Neighbourhood Policing Team, MTCBC ASB department, SWP ASB Officer, and Merthyr Valley Homes against the two repeat offenders of kicking doors in the Trelewis area. Since action was taken by all

departments, there has been a drastic decrease in calls received. This was a previous PACT priority.

Multiagency parking operation that took place on 24/03/2026.

SWP Neighbourhood Policing Team along with MTCBC Community Wardens executed a joint parking operation in the areas of Trelewis, Bedlinog and Treharris. As part of this operation, both organisations spent the day issuing fixed penalty notices to vehicles that were:

- Parked on double yellow lines
- Causing an obstruction of the pavement
- Parked in a permit bay without a permit.

As a result, a total of twenty-six fixed penalty notices were issued to offending vehicles. The operation produced a successful result and is something that we would be looking to conduct again in the future.

The Clerk reminded Councillors that the next PACT meeting is Thursday 16th April, in Trelewis Community Centre. Attendance at PACT is appropriate during the pre-election period. There are bingo and refreshments taking place after the PACT meeting, and the Clerk advised Councillors to be mindful of the pre-election period if considering attendance at any additional activities taking place after the meeting.

Cllr Dawson asked if the NHW Trelewis and Bedlinog District be invited to attend a future Council meeting to provide an update on their activities.
